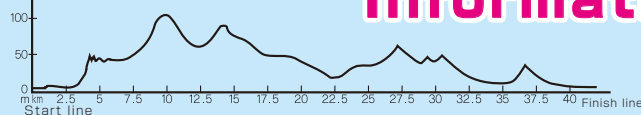

Nagasakibana

Rough waves on the East China Sea throw spray high into the air along the long, narrow rocky coast of Nagasakibana, the southernmost point on the Satsuma Peninsula. The area, which figures in the legend of Urashima Taro, offers beautiful views of Mt. Kaimon.

Mt. Kaimon

With an elevation of 924 meters, Mt. Kaimon, a double volcano of striking beauty, is known as the "Satsuma Fuji." Its summit, which can be climbed in two hours, offers panoramic views.

Flower Park Kagoshima

This botanical garden, which is located close to Nagasakibana at the southernmost tip of the Satsuma Peninsula, takes advantage of the topography of the surrounding natural pine forest. Visitors can enjoy plants from around the world on a large, 36.5-hectare site.
